Criteria

- Associate Professor/ Professor of Education;
- Serving faculty member of the Department of Education in Public and Private Sector Universities;
- Serving faculty member in the Private Sector Teacher Education Institutions;
- Ten years teaching, research and management experience in Teacher Education Institution/ Department;
- At least five years of experience in the present Institution/ Department;
- Trained NACTE external evaluator; and
- The parent Institution/Department must have accreditation of its programmes.
